
Take a journey from Sydney to Canberra with a 2 night stopover in the picturesque Southern Highlands. Capture the natural beauty and rich history that this region has to offer.

Day 1: Sydney to Bowral

Distance: 119 km

Centennial Winery

Historic Berrima
